The Coffee Shop is in need of extra help, serving our customers or working in the kitchen, and anyone in our society who feels they could give some time either every week, every other week or once a month, would be very acceptable. The days on which we are looking for extra help are Tuesday, Thursday or Friday. Our opening times are 10 to 12.30, except on a Thursday when we close at 12.15.

The Coffee Shop, which holds a 5 star council rating, is an outreach part of our Church. We meet some very interesting people, some regularly and some who are on holiday in the area. The holiday people often say they look for a church café when on holiday. We have handed over in the past year £8,000 to the church account and over £300 to our charity for the year from our tips box.

For the next three months we will not be opening on a Saturday because either we can't staff the day or we are closed due to coffee being served in the hall at other events. Ideally we would like to find a leader for a Saturday who would join the leaders of the other days.
