British Red Cross Everyday First Aid session for the over 65s Monday, 23rd March, 2-4 pm in the Cerne Abbas room

The programme is free of charge and is designed to educate people to a basic level of First Aid using everyday items, and equip them with the knowledge and skills required to deal with a First Aid emergency that may arise within their home or social setting.
