DORSET HISTORIC CHURCHES RIDE AND STRIDE - SATURDAY 9 SEPTEMBER 2017

Dorset Historic Churches Trust provides funds to help churches and parishes keep their buildings weatherproof, warm and available for worship and wider public use.

In recent years it has helped with grants for the addition of kitchens and toilets to increase usability of buildings which have traditionally only been used on Sundays.

In 2016 the Trust awarded grants totalling £100,000 to 25 churches. Over the past three years a number of our members at UCD have taken part in the event and received sponsorship, half of which comes straight back to UCD.

Most of the Trust's income comes from the Ride and Stride and last year almost £81,000 was raised in sponsorship by participants of all ages and abilities with 50% of all money pledged returned by the Trust to churches nominated by the riders or striders, so everyone benefits.

Pennies in a Potty - Saturday 23 September

On 23 September we will have various potties outside the front of Church in South Street along with a display board saying why we are doing this and asking people if they can spare any pennies (or paper money) which they would like to put in a potty as they pass by.

This will be the second event held as part of the Mid Life Crisis Group's **Toilet Twinning Programme**. We hope this will result in **all** the toilets here at United Church being twinned with those in countries without proper sanitation systems. Lack of sanitation facilities leads to infections, poor health and quality of life.

We also hope that people will be encouraged to twin their own toilet at home.


