



Holy Communion at UCD in response to the pandemic

After introducing new ways to conduct a service of Holy Communion safely under the Covid restrictions, we have updated the procedures again as we move to one Sunday service:

The Minister and Stewards will continue to wear a visor/mask and gloves. Gluten free bread is brought round to each member of the congregation and is placed in their hands at arm's length. The congregation waits so that everyone can eat their bread at the same time.

The Minister and Stewards then bring wine to each member of the congregation. Again, everyone waits so that the whole congregation can drink their wine at the same time. The Stewards come round after the final communion prayer to collect the glasses.

We hope that you will all find this an acceptable way of enabling us to celebrate the Lord's Supper and carry out His instruction, "Do this in remembrance of me."
