Holy Week Services and Events

- On Wednesday morning, we have our short 20-minute service at 10.45am led by Rev John Yarrien, and "Walk With Me", an interactive prayer space with stations reflecting on Holy Week, from 9.30am until 1.30pm.
- On Thursday there is a service of Holy Communion at 7.30pm, as we recall Jesus' Last Supper with His disciples.
- On Good Friday there is a Walk of Witness organised by Churches Together, starting with a short service at St Peter's Church at 9.30am, walking slowly down South Street, and concluding with another short service at the War Memorial.
- On Holy Saturday, we shall be giving out daffodils and mini chocolate eggs in South Street from 10.30am until 12 noon.
- On Easter Sunday, there is the Son-Rise Service at Maumbury Rings at 6am, and then at 10.30am our Easter Day Celebration Service, which will include Holy Communion.
